



Training for multipliers- Global education

How to raise awareness on global issues among people who are not everyday users of youth centres, NGOs and/or do not attend organized activities? Easy, we go to the streets and perform street education! Training will offer tools for youth workers, trainers, volunteers who are interested in promoting global and nonformal education on the street. Participants will learn about the global and street education approach. After the training, they will be asked to organize two street actions in their countries and report about the effects and impact.

GLOBAL Nonformal Street education education education

The main topics which we will explore through education on the street will be:

agriculture, migration and climate change.



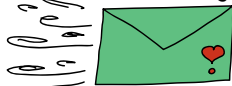
After the training, participants will:

- Have the knowhow on how to organize, carry out and evaluate a street action with a global/nonformal education approach,
- Organize 2 street actions in their country of origin in cooperation with their sending organization,
- Understand what global education and street education consist of and will know the differences of applying the GE methods in schools, NGOs or on the street.

Profile of participants

Interested in global, nonformal education and street education with a strong motivation and some previous experience in youth work. Be able to carry out two street actions in their country in cooperation with their sending organization upon return and multiply the approach further, also through staying in touch with the project GE Agora and support its other activities. Minimum age of the participants is 18 years.

Accommodation

The group will be accommodated in the hostel **Ostello del Sole** in **San Cataldo** an area of **Lecce** that is on the coast. The address is: **Via Amerigo Vespucci** It's very close to the beach and 10 km from the centre of Lecce.

All meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner) will be provided by the project in the hostel. There are some rooms for 4 people and some for 2 people and shared bathrooms.

Internet is available so you can bring your laptop if you need. But keep in mind that especially with many devices connected the wi-fi might get slow.

You have to bring your towels with you, because there are no towels in the rooms.

In Italy the plugs have three holes.

You may need to bring/buy an adapter.

Background of the training

This training is part of a bigger strategic partnership project **Global education Agora**

Travel



You can travel to Lecce by **plane**. The closest airports are in **Brindisi** and **Bari** and some low cost companies fly from there, such as Ryanair and Wizzair. In case you can't find a cheap flight, you can change in Rome or Milan.

Arrival day is the 12th of September and departure day is the 14th of September. We can reimburse up to 275 € per person, but we ask you to find the cheapest ticket possible. **Consult responsible people in each country before buying the tickets.**

Bari airport (aeroporto di Bari) you can take:

- a local train called Ferrovie Nord Barese to Bari centrale (Bari train station). You can find it on the left of the airport.
